## Cookies Policy

### What are Cookies?

Cookies are small text files stored on your computer or mobile phone when you visit your website. Cookies help us to better manage and improve the efficiency of the website.

Through Cookies we monitor the behavior of users on the website to personalize your experience and allow you to use many useful features of the website.

The stateinspector.ge website uses "first-party cookies" that are necessary for the stateinspector.ge website to offer the services requested by the user.

"First-party cookies" are a type of cookies that are used only by the stateinspector.ge web server, are not transferred to a third party (for example Google) and in most cases are necessary for the operation of the website.

The stateinspector.ge website also uses "third-party cookies" which facilitate the operation of the website or are used only to obtain statistics about the website's users.

### Which cookies do we use and how?

The following "Cookies" are used on the Service website:

Name of Cookies	Description
PHP Session Technical Identifier	<p>It is used to identify a user session and is essential for the use of the website.</p> <p>The technical identifier of the PHP session is stored in the user's computer as a cookie and as a web browser.</p> <p>When closed, this cookie will be automatically deleted.</p>

Google Analytic User Internal Identifier

Google Analytics is a simple, easy-to-use tool that helps web site owners obtain statistics about site users.

If you use this analytical tool, your computer will accumulate certain types of cookies.

Google Analytic User Internal Identifier is used to statistically identify users and is stored on the user's computer for 2 years. It can be deleted directly from the web browser settings configured on the computer by the method of deleting the cookies.

Google Analytics Request Time

Google Analytic request time is used to identify the request speed and is stored in the user's computer for 1 minute. It can be deleted directly from the settings of the web browser stored on the computer by deleting the cookie method.

Google Analytic User Temporary Identifier

Google Analytic User Identifier is used to differentiate users and is stored on the user's computer for 24 hours. It can be deleted directly from the web browser settings configured on the computer by the method of deleting the cookies.

Identifier of the language used

Used to specify the language chosen by the user. Identifier of the language used in the user's computer in the form of cookies constantly. It can be deleted directly from the settings of the web browser stored on the computer by deleting the cookies method.
